Liposuction Leeds

Liposuction Leeds is a surgical procedure that involves removal of excess fat from just beneath the skin in problem areas such as the abdomen and thighs. The basic techniques for this procedure were designed back in the 1980s and it was from then on that this surgery gained enormous popularity and since then many great advancements have been made in relation to it. This surgery is most commonly done for cosmetic purposes such as to lose weight, look in better shape and have a better body shape and contour.

Types And Techniques

Different types of liposuction surgery may be opted for based on the techniques employed during the procedure. Popularly known liposuction Leeds techniques include the following:

- Tumescant technique – this techniques involves the administration of large volumes of local anesthesia for the removal of excess fat.
- Dry technique – no local anesthesia is given before

the removal of excess fat pockets in this type of liposuction.

- Wet technique – about 100 millimeters of local anesthesia with epinephrine is used in this procedure.
- Super wet technique – dilute anesthesia equal to a volume half that administered in the tumescent technique is given before the commencement of the surgery.
- Laser liposuction – this provides perhaps the best cosmetic results because the fat is removed using a micro-cannula which is inserted in to fat pockets through very minute incisions. Heat and laser energy is sent in the form of pulses in to the subcutaneous tissue to essentially melt away the fat.
- ProLipo PLUS – this procedure is used specifically for precise shaping and contouring of the body. This newer technique is may be performed under local anesthesia with the use of a special laser that is known to reduce bruising and bleeding considerably.

Liposuction Costs

The total cost of liposuction Leeds varies depending on a number of important factors such as the surgeon's fee,

the anesthesiologist's fee, body areas treated and the health care facility fee. A breakdown of the total costs is as shown below.

Surgeon's fee -- \$2000

Anesthesia -- \$800

Facility care -- \$700

Total cost -- \$3500

The area and the number of body areas treated is perhaps the most important factor that decides how much the surgery will cost you; liposuction Leeds costs by body area are as follows:

- Upper and lower abdomen -- \$3,000 to \$7,500
- Arms -- \$1500 to \$4,000
- Buttocks -- \$1,500 to \$4,500
- Breasts -- \$3,000 to \$7,500
- Chin, jowls, neck or cheeks -- \$2,000 to \$4,500
- Flanks -- \$2,000 to \$5,000
- Knees and inner thighs -- \$2,000 to \$5,000
- Knees and anterior thighs -- \$2,000 to \$5,000
- Outer thighs -- \$1,600 to \$5,000
- Hips or waist -- \$1,600 to \$5,000
